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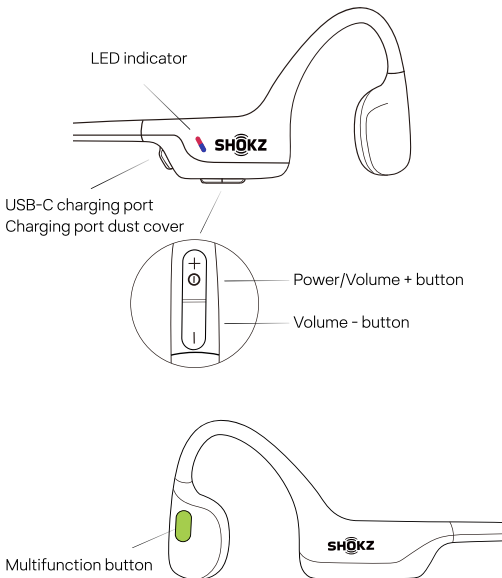
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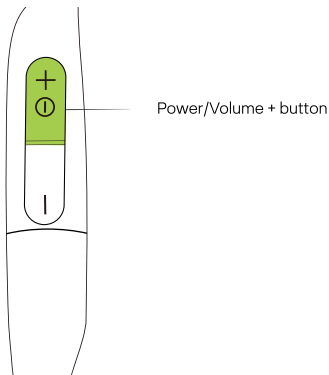
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# HOW IT WORKS

# Headphone Controls



# On / Off



## Turn on the headphones:

Press and hold the Power/Volume + button until the LED indicator flashes blue.

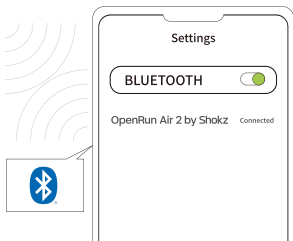
## Turn off the headphones:

Press and hold the Power/Volume + button until the LED indicator flashes red.

# Pairing



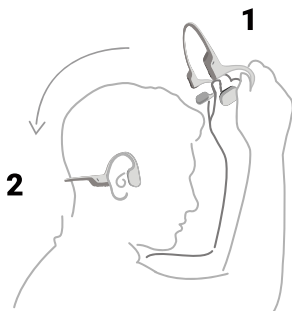
1. Start with OpenRun Air 2 turned off.
2. Press and hold the Volume + button until the LED indicator flashes red and blue alternately.



3. Open your device's Bluetooth settings and select "OpenRun Air 2 by Shokz".



# How to wear



Pick up the headphones, bring them behind the back of the base of your neck, position the earhooks on your ears, then enjoy your music!

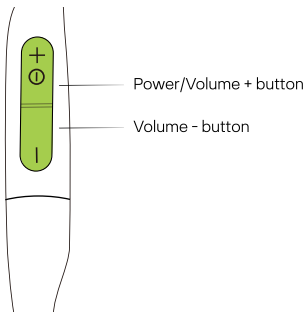
\*Wearing your headphones the wrong way could cause discomfort. The transducers should rest in front of your ears.

# BUTTON CONTROLS

# Volume



Operate while audio is playing.



How to change volume:

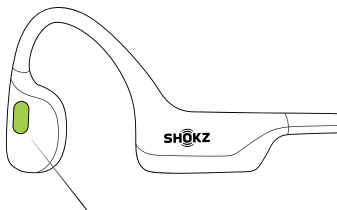
While your audio is playing, adjust headphone volume by pushing either the Volume + or Volume - buttons.

\*A "beep" will sound when the volume is at its max.



\*Listening with headphones at high volume may affect your hearing and the audio will be distorted.

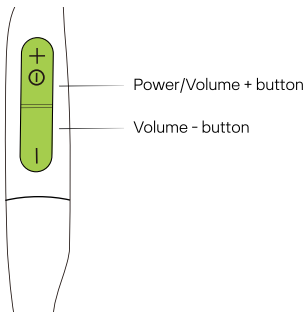

| Switch prompt language                         | In pairing mode (red and blue lights flashing alternately), click the multifunction button x2 |
| Answer the second call and end the first call  | When a second call comes in, click the multifunction button x2                                |
| End the second call and keep the first call    | When a second call comes in, press and hold the multifunction button for 2 seconds            |
| Answer the second call and keep the first call | When a second call comes in, click the multifunction button x1                                |
| Switch between calls (toggle to the held call) | During a multi-call, click the multifunction button x1                                        |
| End the current call in a multi-call           | During a multi-call, press and hold the multifunction button for 2 seconds                    |

\*The call-related functions above apply only to phone calls, and do not apply to voice or video calls made through third-party applications.

# Check Battery Status



Operate controls while audio is not playing.



How to check battery status:

Click the Volume + or Volume - button while music is paused.

\*Voice prompt: "Battery high/Battery medium/Battery low/Charge me."

# EQ Mode Description



## Standard:

Balanced frequencies,  
suitable for everyday music  
listening



## Volume Boost:

Increased volume output,  
suitable for noisy outdoor  
environments



## Vocal:

Enhanced mid frequencies,

courses, and spoken audio



## Privacy:

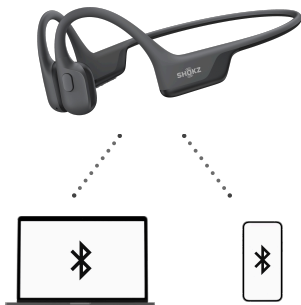
Controls high-frequency

# MultiPoint Pairing



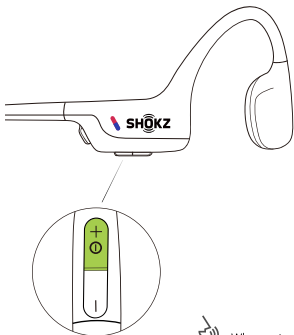
## Connect to Two Devices Simultaneously:

One pair of headphones can connect to two Bluetooth devices at the same time, enabling seamless switching between devices. Handle multiple tasks with ease.

# Enable MultiPoint Pairing

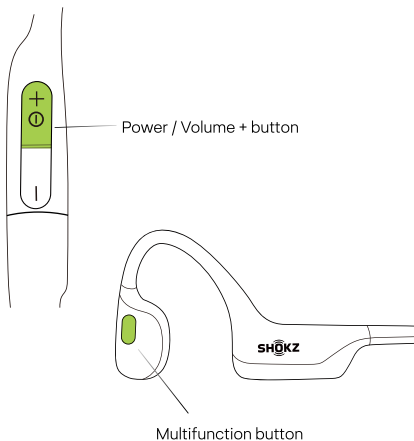


Operate when the headphones are powered off.

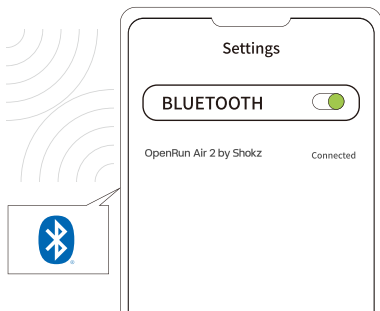


When entering pairing mode, you'll hear "Pairing".

1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
2. Press and hold the Power / Volume + button until the red and blue indicator lights flash alternately to enter pairing mode. You will hear "Pairing".

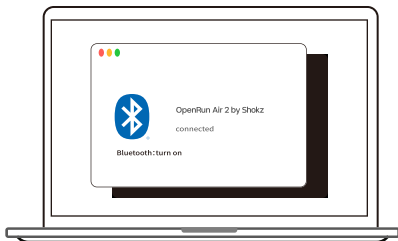


3. Press and hold both the Multi-function button and the Power / Volume + button until you hear a “beep” tone.



## First Device

4. Open the Bluetooth pairing list on Device 1 and select "OpenRun Air 2 by Shokz" to connect.
5. Power off the headphones.



## Second Device

6. Re-enter pairing mode.
7. Open the Bluetooth pairing list on Device 2 and select "OpenRun Air 2 by Shokz" to connect.
8. Power off the headphones again.



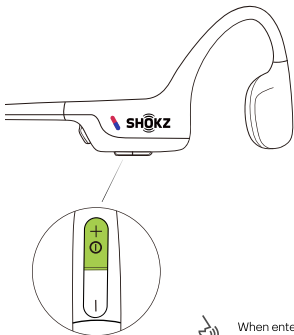
9. Press and hold the Power / Volume + button to turn on the headphones. After the power-on prompt, the headphones will automatically connect to both devices, with two connection confirmation tones.

\*You can also use the Shokz App for convenient multipoint pairing management.

# Turn MultiPoint Pairing Off



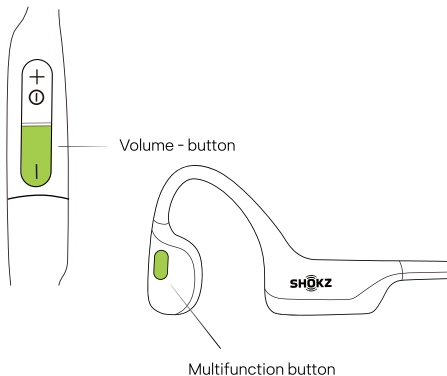
Operate controls with headphones powered off.



When entering pairing mode, you'll hear "Pairing".

1. Start with your headphones powered off.
2. Press and hold Volume + until you hear "Pairing" and the LED indicator flashes red and blue alternately.

\*Voice prompt: "Pairing."



3. Press and hold the multifunction button and Volume - button until you hear "MultiPoint disabled."

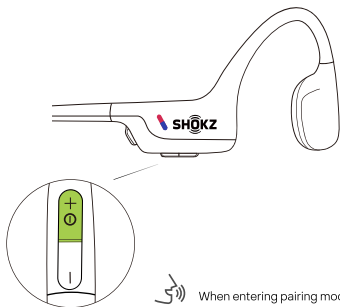
\*Voice prompt: "MultiPoint disabled."



# Changing Languages

Your headphones have four built-in languages:  
Chinese, English, Japanese and Korean.

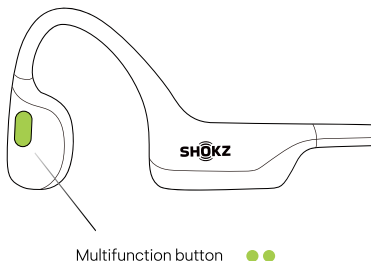
**OFF** Operate controls with headphones powered off.



When entering pairing mode, you'll hear "Pairing".

1. Start with your headphones powered off.
2. Press and hold Volume + until you hear "Pairing" and the LED indicator flashes red and blue alternately.

\*Voice prompt: "Pairing."



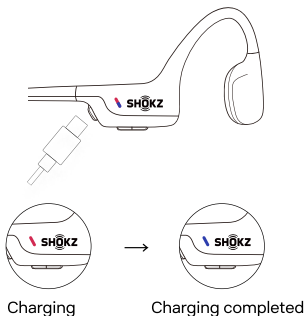
3. Double click the multifunction button. Languages have been switched when you hear the corresponding language.

\*You can also use the Shokz App to conveniently switch the voice prompt language.

# Charging Notice

**OFF** The headphones will automatically power off during charging.



When the battery is low, the headphones will emit a low-battery alert tone, and the red indicator light will flash intermittently. Please connect the charging cable to charge the device.

During charging, the LED indicator will turn red and the headphones will automatically power off. When the indicator turns blue, charging is complete.

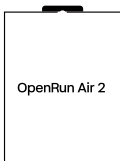
# Storage and Maintenance

- Store the headphones in a cool, dry place. The working temperature should be 0~40°C (32 ~ 104°F).
- Keep the headphones away from heat sources, combustible gas or other clean/corrosive liquids, keep the headphones away from a long time of direct sunlight, using or placing in hot places.
- Stop using the headphones immediately if any parts are damaged, smoking, hot, or have a burning smell.
- The dust and water resistance level of the product is IP67. The product can be submerged in up to 1 meter of fresh water for up to 30 minutes. IP67 is not a permanent protection rating and may be degraded through normal wear and tear.
- Clean the headphones with a soft dry cloth.
- After storage for a long period, please charge the headphones before using again.
